

- 3. The spiritual talks of the Instructor have changed the thoughts of the participants.


Conclusion

My own height measured at 156.2, and the assessment wasn't just about numbers; it was a checkpoint ensuring everyone was physically ready for the challenges ahead. The air buzzed with a mix of excitement and anticipation.

Flat Foot and Knock Knee Assessment

Shoes off, the flat foot and knock knee evaluation revealed no issues for many participants, myselincluded

Running -

The running track beckoned, and before others, participants were directed to complete 5 rounds the ground. This unexpected twist added an extra layer of physical exertion, setting a benchmark for endurance and determination.

Parade Practice

It wasn't just precision; it was about coordination, teamwork, and embodying the spirit of unity. The parade practice, conducted on a sunny day, added an extra layer of toughness. Yet, under the glaring sun, participants pushed through, showcasing resilience and commitment.
